For Vacation Bible School, as our students gathered to learn about God's Wonder Lab, we collected items to be sent to students around the world. Help us collect items to educate students. Help us reach our goal to send 50 kits!

Following is a list of what is needed for us to reach our goal of completing 50

school kits:

25 round tip scissors (no plastic scissors)
25 packs of crayons (24 crayons to a box)
83 notebooks (single subject wire bound notebooks; no composition notebooks)
25 packs of loose-leaf paper (100-200 sheets)
19 hand-held pencil sharpeners (1" or longer)
21 rulers (12" - sturdy or flexible material)
66 pencils (unsharpened)
21 erasers (2" or longer)
