

IN ORDER TO CELEBRATE YOUR WEDDING AND MARRIAGE, PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

SERVICE, SCHEDULE, & FACILITIES:

We celebrate your blessed day in the midst of the other ministries at the church. Times and dates for the wedding and rehearsal will be set jointly with the couple, the pastor, and the Church administrator on behalf of the church facility schedule.

Our wedding services reflect Christian worship. An outline of the service is in this booklet. Specific requests and liturgical desires should be discussed with the pastor.

Music is a blessing in many services. If you wish to have music, please contact our musician, Marti Lantz at 570-421-6020. This includes the use of the piano, organ, and sound system.

Bulletins often assist your guests during the service.

If you would like the church office to produce worship bulletins, information must be to the office a week in advance. Candles and flowers are the responsibility of the Wedding Party.

Ministries continue at the church. All set-up and clean-up are the responsibility of the wedding party. The wedding party is responsible for ensuring the set-up of the room is restored and clean-up completed. Clean-up arrangements can also be made for a fee.

Our facility is the site of many ministries. Please help us to maintain it. Please do not throw anything which cannot be easily cleaned from the site by the wedding party. Bird seed, rice, confetti, and candy are examples of items which are deemed NOT acceptable. We are a non-smoking property; therefore, smoking is prohibited.

Please arrange building openings with the church office or pastor,

Pictures may be taken before, during, and after the ceremony.

Fees: These fees are negotiable if need exists. Our goal as a congregation is to help you grow in the fullness of life in Christ.

- **Deposit of \$100 to reserve date.**
- **Building Use Fee for Non-members/Non-attenders:** \$600
- **Honorarium for Pastor:** At the discretion of the wedding party (suggested honorarium is \$300).
- **Music Director:** \$200 (Includes Rehearsal and Wedding)
\$50 if coordinating other musicians
- **Janitorial Service:** \$100
- **Bulletins:** \$25 (if church produces and provides. Fee may vary in relation to number of bulletins needed)
- **Prepare/ Enrich Premarital Inventory:** \$35 paid directly to Prepare/Enrich at www.prepare-enrich.com

Balance is due at Rehearsal

Maximum sanctuary capacity: 250
